A. Description

This course is designed to develop high school level musical techniques (i.e. singing pitches, reading music and challenging rhythms, playing an instrument at a high school level), audition expectations and processes, and small ensemble focus will be given throughout this course.

5. Introduction to solo and ensemble.
6. Methodology to practice and repair.
7. An overview on approaching an audition for band.
